



Workers' Comp Increase effective January 1, 2009 is 3.6%.

2009 workers' compensation fees are generally equal to 191.5% of 1994 Medicare with the exception of new and revised codes.

Notice to Practices Who Have Ordered the WC Fee Schedule in Prior Years

You are advised to order a new fee schedule each year because your old one will not contain fees for **new and revised** codes. Therefore, revising your old fee schedule will result in inaccurate information. In addition, you should be aware that the 2009 WC fee schedule can be downloaded from the Bureau's website (www.dli.state.pa.us) at no charge. **HOWEVER, IT IS NOT IN THE SAME FORMAT, NOR AS USER-FRIENDLY AS POS PROVIDES!** It includes **all 4 geographic areas** and **all codes**. Also, it does not contain **any decimal points**.



IMPORTANT!

All workers' comp insurance carriers and self insured employers will receive notice of the 3.6% increase effective January 1, 2009 from the Bureau of Workers' Comp in Harrisburg. A copy of this same notice will be contained in the winter issue of the POS newsletter, which will be available at www.paorthosociety.org. **Forwarding a copy of this notice with your claims to carriers, which continue to pay you at an old rate, may be helpful.**
