Display Highlights State and National Orthopaedic Associations Milestones

The Harrisburg Capitol will host the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons' 75th Anniversary exhibit, *Moving Stories*, commemorating the last 75 years in orthopaedic history, research and innovation. Provided by the Pennsylvania Orthopaedic Society, *Moving Stories* is a unique project that commemorates the historical innovations and successes in the last 75 years of orthopaedics. The exhibit, open September 16-25, 2008, illustrates innovations in joint replacement and the importance of industry developments in American orthopaedics since the founding of the Academy in 1933.

Moving Stories includes several topic areas; Joint Replacement, The Future and Orthopaedic Industry are featured at the Capitol. Peruse the history of orthopaedics and be immersed in facts, statistics, stories and images from these topic areas. This history of orthopaedics not only shares personal, detailed accounts of individuals, but also chronicles the great strides made in the treatment of orthopaedics as a result of research and innovation, at the beginning of the 20th Century.

In 2008, the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS) celebrates its 75th year with a multi-media celebration including a Web site (aaos.org/75years), historical and coffee table books, art show, Digital Timelines, a documentary film, and a traveling exhibit, *Moving Stories*.

The Pennsylvania Orthopaedic Society celebrated its own 50th Anniversary in 2006 by earning **Society of the Year** honors from the AAOS. Together, the state and national organizations have made strides not just for orthopaedic surgeons but for the patients they provide care for as well. Members of AAOS and POS have been at the forefront of innovation in the field, bringing new techniques and better results to their patients.
